



Continuing Education Scholarship 2012 application packet

A scholarship opportunity for public or private high school or home school graduating seniors who are dependents of current St. Croix Electric Cooperative members.

About the scholarship program: St. Croix Electric Cooperative's Youth Scholarship Program was started in 1981 by the members and directors of St. Croix Electric. Since that time, thousands of dollars have been awarded to students from throughout SCEC's service area.

How scholarships are awarded: A scholarship committee of cooperative members determines the awards based on a point system. In selecting recipients, attention is given to applicants with accomplishments in academic achievement, scholastic activities, leadership, community involvement and knowledge of cooperatives. **Students enrolling in one or two-year technical/vocational certification schools or four-year colleges are welcome to apply. The scholarship program is divided into these two categories, so students enrolling in technical schools will be competing against others enrolling in technical schools. Students enrolling in four year colleges and universities will be competing against other students enrolling in four year schools.**

Applicant eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a public, private or home schooled graduating senior this school year.
2. Applicant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be full-time, active members of St. Croix Electric Cooperative.
3. The completed application, principal/guidance counselor form and an official transcript must be received by **3/19/12**.
4. Applicant must fill out this form, sign it and mail or deliver it to the cooperative's office in Hammond.
5. The principal/guidance counselor's form must be completed, signed and mailed or delivered to the cooperative's office.
6. The official school transcript must be mailed or delivered to the cooperative's office in Hammond.
7. **Applications, forms and transcripts received after 3/19/12 will not be considered.**

Scholarship recipients are required to supply proof of full-time enrollment before funds can be distributed. Scholarship checks are made out to the schools.
